The Architectural Review Commission will review and act on the following building applications for permits on *August 16, 2018 in the Whitefish Bay Library at 5420 N. Marlborough Dr. – Second Floor ******

1. **4747 N. Woodruff Ave. – Jason Sullivan** - The proposed project is to review the plans for an arbor that was built as part of a fence.
2. **5321 N. Berkeley Blvd. – Darcie Hartford** – The proposed project is to raze the existing 20' x 20' detached frame garage and to construct a new 22' x 22' detached frame Gable style garage as per survey.
3. **6121 N. Lake Dr. – Greg & Sandy Bugbee** – The proposed project is to remove all of the existing brick from the entire house and replace it with a more appealing red brick. Also, 4 new dormers will be constructed. The siding will also be replaced with a cement fiber board.
4. **1051 E. Circle Dr. – Brian Cole & Emmie Cerow** – The proposed project is to construct/rebuild a previous family room addition and bumping out an exterior kitchen wall.
