The homeowners and Matt Jones, the contractor, were present to explain the project while the Board reviewed the submitted plans and video. Discussion keys: Make addition all brick, don't replace door on back with window; get rid of dormer; roof pitches don't match. No neighbors in attendance. **After further discussion, James Hoffman made a motion to approve the plans as submitted with the condition that brick is used all the way up instead of siding. Peter Quehl seconded. A vote was taken and unanimously passed. (6-0)** 

The **second** item on the agenda is **5226 N. Santa Monica Blvd.** –The proposed project is to expand the style of the home and modernize the garage to a compliant 2-car garage on the front of the house. Also, a proposed addition will be added to the house. (1,342sf) The homeowners were present to explain the project while the Board reviewed the submitted plans and video. Discussion keys: Placement of downspout on front of house; scale & massing; drainage to be away from neighbors. No neighbors in attendance. **After further discussion, Peter Quehl made a motion to approve the plans as submitted. James Hoffman seconded. A vote was taken and unanimously passed. (6-0)**
