

#### LEAVE THE FIREWORKS TO THE PROFESSIONALS

With July 4th festivities quickly approaching, North Shore Fire/Rescue would like to remind everyone to leave the fireworks to the professionals at the various displays around the North Shore.

The National Fire Protection Agency reports that in 2011, fireworks caused approximately 17,800 fires, resulting in 8 deaths, 40 civilian injuries and approximately \$32 million in property damage.

Likewise, hospitals report treating approximately 9,600 patients with fireworks related injuries in 2011.

Even fireworks like sparklers, which are widely thought to be the safest fireworks, can have devastating consequences. The tip of a sparkler burns at nearly 1,200 de-

grees Fahrenheit, putting the user and anyone who may be around the user at a risk for serious and potentially life threatening burns. The truth is, there is no safe firework on the market.

The safest way to enjoy fireworks is to attend a public display conducted by trained professionals. In addition, after the display, children should never pick up fireworks that may be left over, as they may still be active. Any fireworks should be disposed of in a metal container after being well soaked in water to ensure any risk for accidental ignition is kept to an absolute minimum. All of us at North Shore Fire/Rescue wish everyone a happy and safe 4th of July celebration.

### 4TH OF JULY IN WHITEFISH BAY



eggplants, black currants, blueberries and strawberries.





**FISHING – WHITEFISH BAY’S FIRST COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISE**

Aside from farming (where the trade of goods actually occurred in downtown Milwaukee), fishing off Whitefish Bay’s bountiful waters and selling the day’s catch on the sandy shoreline was Whitefish Bay’s first real business venture. The article below from the July 17, 1862 Milwaukee Sentinel describes a journalist’s excursion to see John Luck’s fishing operation in the waters off Whitefish Bay.

Five minutes’ pull brings you to the pounds; a few minutes’ inextricable twisting of ropes, ducking of heads and, in our case, a continual chorus of nautical phrases, in which all joined and above which the horse laugh could be heard loud and distinct.

After getting in sight of the web, the doors are shut and the net pulled up, so as to bring the fishes near the surface. The sight is well worth seeing. The water becomes alive with the finny creatures, all wiggling, gliding and squirming in an almost solid mass of tails, heads and fins. Thousands of the silvery herring, the plump, scintillating whitefish, the broad flounder, the succulent bass, the rank sheep’s head, the great sluggish sturgeon, the pickerel and many others, all massed in a living community. The visitors are allowed to haul out all they want, which is easily done, as they (the fish) are so congregated that they can be caught with the hand.

The scene is an exciting one, and Mr. Luck, who owns the nets, takes great delight in the interest shown at his unique exhibition. Parties always come to shore with selected strings of fish for which a mere nominal fee is charged.

On our arrival, a party of gentlemen was observed, accompanied with ladies, who had just been out to visit the pound.

The scenery in the vicinity is picturesque and the locality pleasant.

Did you know that when it is 72 degrees outside, a temperature many of us really enjoy, a car parked in a shady area can have an internal temperature as high as 117 degrees Fahrenheit! Unfortunately, most dogs are not welcome in grocery stores, or other places where you might be running a quick errand. Even if you think that your animal will be fine because you will only be a moment, and you will crack the windows, please think twice about taking your dog with you. Leaving your companion home can save their life!

Milwaukee Area Domestic Animal Control Commission responds to several calls each day in warm weather to rescue or provide aid to animals left alone in cars in hot temperatures. Sadly, despite many warnings about animals in hot cars we see many animals with heatstroke and several fatalities each year. These injuries and deaths do not have to happen.

If you see an animal in a car on a warm day, first try and find the owner. Many businesses are happy to help and make an announcement to notify a patron that their animal is in crisis. If you are unable to find the owner, please contact your local police department for assistance using the non-emergency number.



Summer is also the prime season for canine parvo-virus, which is an easily preventable disease with proper vaccination. # Strawberry Tiramisu

By Chef Jordan Brolund

- 1 cup whipping cream
- 1 eight ounce package Mascarpone cheese, softened
- 1 eight ounce package cream cheese, softened
- ½ cup honey
- ½ cup powdered sugar, sifted
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 pint strawberries, thinly sliced (*reserve three or four whole for garnish*)
- 2 three ounce packages Lady Fingers (*located in the bakery section*)
- 1 cup strawberry liqueur (*may substitute orange juice*)
- ¼ cup white rum (*may substitute orange juice*)
- Mint leaves and strawberries for garnish

Chill a mixing bowl, beat whipping cream with an electric mixer until stiff peaks form. Add Mascarpone and cream cheese to whipping cream and beat well. Add honey and powdered sugar to cheese mixture and beat well. Add salt and vanilla and beat well then set aside.

In a separate bowl, mix liqueur and rum.

To present this dessert, use a tall trifle bowl or a clear bowl that will show off layers.

Dip Lady Fingers one at a time into the liqueur and arrange a layer in bottom of bowl. Place one fourth of cream mixture on top of Lady Fingers. Place one third of strawberries on top of the cream mixture. Repeat this process two more times. End with a layer of cream.

Garnish with strawberries and fresh mint leaves. Serves 12.

**Take advantage** of the abundance of locally-grown strawberries while they are currently in season and can be found at great prices. Stock up now for the fall and winter months. Lightly rinse and pat dry the berries.



Arrange in a single layer on a cookie sheet and place in the freezer for two hours. Remove from freezer and place in zip closure freezer bags then return to freezer. This will allow you to take out just the amount of berries you wish to use at any given time.
