From Marquette University to the Milwaukee Bucks, Novak Family Calls Whitefish Bay Home



It's said that what doesn't kill you makes you stronger, and moving 17 times within a 10-year period, has certainly made Steve and Christina Novak a stronger couple. The adorable pair, with Steve towering over petite Christina, first met while both were undergraduate students at Marquette University. While the two had a class together, they didn't actually meet until both traveled to New Orleans, when Marquette was in the NCAA Final Four basketball tournament in 2003. Steve was playing his freshman year for Marquette University's basketball team, and Christina went down with friends to cheer the team on. While in New Orleans the two met through mutual MU friends, and have been together ever since, getting married in 2007.

Steve began his professional NBA basketball career in 2006 with the Houston Rockets, and since then has played for 9 different teams in 11 years. In the couple's chicly decorated home, they have a wall with each of the 9 states framed, and a small heart to mark the city where they lived in each place. They bought their house in Whitefish Bay in 2012, and regardless of which city Steve was playing in, they always called Whitefish Bay home. "Steve grew up in Brown Deer, and we wanted to stay close to family. When we first bought our house in Whitefish Bay, we thought

it would just be for a few years. We fell in love with the community, our neighbors and the school system, so we won't be moving away anytime soon," said Christina.

Last year Steve was traded to the Milwaukee Bucks, and his dream of



representing his hometown team came true. "Being able to play for a team that I grew up cheering for, in the place that I call home, is more than I ever dreamed of," said Steve, with a huge grin on his face. Steve grew up in a basketball loving family, with his father, Mike Novak, coaching him all along the way. Mike played for Carroll College, and then coached basketball for 32 years, with

24 of those years being at Brown Deer High School, where he is currently the Athletic Director. "Growing up I was my dad's shadow because he would happily bring me everywhere with him. From age five on, I would be dropped off at his basketball practices after school, and be with him all evening long. He instilled in me the love I have for basketball and always made it fun and enjoyable. He passed his love of the game onto me, and helped me pursue my dreams of being a high-level player. He is the single biggest reason I have been able to make it at the NBA level for the last decade," said Steve.

His father's efforts on the basketball court also extended to get a referendum passed to build a new field house for the Brown Deer schools. The facility was built in 2013 and is one of the finest in the Midwest, with 4 basketball courts, an indoor track, rock-climbing wall, and fitness center. Steve also backed his father's efforts by donating \$100,000 to the facility, which was kept a secret from Mike until the opening ceremony. When it came to naming the facility, it was only fitting that the community honored both Mike and Steve by naming it The Novak Family Field House.

Aside from basketball, the couple stays busy with their two young children, Mack (6) and Shea (3), and their rescue

dog, Bella. When Steve was re-signed with the Bucks for the upcoming season it was a huge sigh of relief that the family would be able to stay here for the full year. "When we received the call that

the Bucks wanted bring the hometown boy back for another season we were thrilled! All four of us went to the Bucks training facility to officially sign for the upcoming season, and as the pen was gliding across the paper I could feel the weight lifted off my shoulders and see the smile getting bigger on Steve's face, both knowing we would be home this year, no moving come fall! Mack and Shea could stay at school in the place we chose to call home, not the place someone

Whitefish Bay offers. "It will be great to see family, friends and neighbors cheering on the Bucks this season during our home games. I hope a lot of Whitefish Bay families are able to take in a few games this coming season," said Steve.



Don't Wait – Check the Date! Replace Smoke Alarms Every 10 Years

Can you believe fall is already here? It is that time of the year again, as we prepare to “fall back” by rolling our clocks back for one extra hour of sleep on Sunday, November 6th; we also need to heed the warning from this year’s Fire Prevention Week theme: Don’t Wait-Check the Date!

This is the last year of the National Fire Protection Agency’s three-year campaign focused on basic smoke alarm safety messages. Often times, resident fail to realize that much like milk in a refrigerator, your smoke alarms also have an expiration date; generally, smoke alarms are good for 10 years or less.


You can easily check the date on most smoke alarms by looking at the sticker near where your battery is installed. Even alarms that are wired into the home electrical system often have a backup battery, and will always have a manufacturer date.

Recent statistics from North Shore Fire/Rescue’s free home assessment program have revealed that nearly 70% of alarms found in

homes during our visit, are actually past their effective life expectancy.

When shopping for a replacement alarm, it is best to ensure you are purchasing one that bears the logo of Underwriter Laboratories (UL), Intertek (ETL), or another nationally recognized independent third-party testing laboratory. Recently, sites like Amazon and other retailers were asked by National Fire Marshal groups to remove alarms being sold that did not meet these requirements. Unfortunately, this process takes time, and these alarms are still out there and available for purchase.

As a reminder, alarms should be located on every level of the home and inside and outside of every sleeping area (bedroom). North Shore Fire/Rescue offers a home assessment program that includes the installation of free smoke alarms for all North Shore residents. the top.



Pumpkin Pie Spiced Almonds

This recipe is truly one of my favorites (refined sugar-free, gluten-free, vegan & paleo). I love setting out a dish at family gatherings or taking them to parties. If you show up with these in hand, I promise you will be complimented well and often!

- 1 cup raw almonds**
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon**
- 1-1/2 tsp pumpkin pie spice**
- 1/4 tsp sea salt**
- 2 tbsp maple syrup**
- 1/2 tsp pure vanilla extract**

Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. While the oven is preheating, pour the almonds into a large mixing bowl. Add cinnamon, pumpkin pie spice and salt. Toss to coat. Drizzle the maple syrup and vanilla extract on the almonds. Stir until all almonds are evenly coated with the mixture. Spray a foil lined cookie sheet with cooking spray and spread the almonds on the sheet in a single layer. Cook for 15-20 minutes, turning once, until almonds are roasted. Let cool completely before storing in an airtight container.

Did you find a stray? Or did you stumble across an injured squirrel? Many people have heard of MADACC and Wisconsin Humane Society (WHS) but are not really sure of which services each organization provides. Here is a handy guide to help avoid confusion and multiple phone calls:

- I have found a stray pet...Contact MADACC at 414-649-8640
- I have found a sick or injured wild animal...Contact WHS at 414-264-6257
- I have a wild animal living on my property and I do not want it there...You must contact a private animal removal service, neither organization provides this service
- There is a dead animal in the street...Contact your local sanitation department
- I have been feeding a cat outside for a period of time and I no longer wish to care for it or this cat has had kittens and I would like to see them be adopted...Contact WHS at 414-264-6257
- I can no longer care for my dog or cat and would like to bring it to a shelter...Contact WHS at 414-264-6257
- I need low cost spay or neuter services, a microchip or low cost vaccinations...Contact either MADACC at 414-649-8640 or WHS at 414-264-6257
- I would like to adopt a new companion animal...Contact either MADACC at 414-649-8640 or WHS at 414-264-6257, or better yet, visit in person!
- My animal is sick or injured and I cannot afford to care for it... First check with your vet about the options available to you or any referral they can provide, otherwise contact WHS at 414-264-6257

- My animal is in need of end of life services or has passed away at home and I need cremation services...Contact either MADACC at 414-649-8640 or WHS at 414-264-6257, please note that there are fees associated with these services
- I cannot afford to feed my pet, can you help?...Contact either MADACC at 414-649-8640 or WHS at 414-264-6257
- I need a dog or cat license or a Dog Park permit...Contact MADACC at 414-649-8640




