The Village of Whitefish Bay will begin the new automated, containerized Residential Refuse and Recycling Collection Program on **Monday, August 20**. Your new, gray refuse cart will be delivered the week of **August 13**. The Village will pick up any unwanted cans on **Saturday, September 8**, for those north of and including Henry Clay St., and **Saturday, September 15**, for those south of Henry Clay St. The information packet attached to your new cart will include the new collection schedule including your A/B recycling designation, new special pickup categories and more.

# NEW AUTOMATED RESIDENTIAL REFUSE & RECYCLING COLLECTION PROGRAM STARTS ON MONDAY, AUGUST 20



### Refuse

**Your New Refuse Cart will be delivered the week of August 13, 2018. New Collection Program will begin Monday, August 20**



- Any additional pre-purchased carts will also be delivered at this time
- Carts will include an information packet with full instructions about collection
- Only the new refuse carts may be used. Old cans will be picked up by the Village free of charge
- Additional Carts may be purchased for \$75

### Collection Schedule Changes:

Refuse Pickup: Once a Week  
Recycling: Every Other Week  
*A/B Recycling Schedule will be delivered with your Refuse Cart*

### Proper Cart Placement for Refuse and Recycling

- Required cart placement is on the parkway or outside alley garage
- Face the lid arrows towards the street and the handle towards the house
- Carts should be placed at least 3 feet apart from each other, and a maximum of 3 feet from the street
- All household waste must be put inside carts for collection
- All Recycling goes in the blue carts, all Refuse in gray carts, all lids must be fully closed on day of collection

### Recycling



- Recycling Carts (official Village blue carts) stay the same and will not be replaced
- All Recycling needs to fit inside the recycling cart (including cardboard) A \$45 fee will be assessed for extra pickup
- Additional Carts may be purchased for \$75
- Collection increases to every other week, from 12 pickups annually to 26
- New Collection Schedule will alternate A or B weeks (*Recycling schedule to be delivered with your new refuse cart week of Aug. 13*)

### Old Refuse Can Pickup

**Free Pickup of Your Old Cans  
7:00am Sat., Sept. 8  
(north of and including Henry Clay St)  
OR  
7:00am Sat., Sept. 15  
(south of Henry Clay St)**

### Special Refuse Pickups

1. Free Pickup: Non domestic waste, under 4'x4'x7' (ex: chair)
2. \$45 Pickup: Non domestic waste, larger than 4'x4'x7' less than 5'x5'x15' (ex: sectional sofa)
3. \$45+ Pickup: Larger than 5'x5'x15' (ex: garage cleanout)
4. Absolutely no grass clippings or contractor waste collected
