



## 2018 Recycling Guidelines

### ACCEPTED

#### Glass Bottles and Jars – Rinsed

- All colors
- Please rinse
- No need to remove labels
- Bottle caps and metal lids

#### Aluminum Cans – Rinsed

- May be crushed

#### Tin/Steel/Bi-Metal Cans – Rinsed

- May be crushed

#### Plastic – Rinsed

- HDPE Plastic milk and water jugs
- Lids and caps of plastic bottles
- Motor oil and antifreeze bottles
- PET plastic containers including 1-2-3 liter pop bottles
- Plastics #1 through #7
- Soda bottles
- Laundry bottles
- Shampoo, conditioner, lotion and cosmetic bottles

#### Paper – Unsoiled

- Brown grocery bags
- Business envelopes, forms
- Construction paper
- Copy/computer/fax paper
- Window type envelopes
- File folders
- Frozen food boxes
- Junk mail
- Magazines
- Newspaper
- Telephone books, paperback books
- Coated paper cartons with plastic screw tops – ex: milk, juice, soup, wine

#### Cardboard – Unsoiled

- Beverage carriers
- Cereal/cake mix/ detergent/bev. boxes
- Corrugated - flatten to maximize space
- Egg cartons (paper or clear plastic)
- Paper towel and toilet paper tubes
- Tissue Boxes (empty)

### NOT ACCEPTED

The following items are not recyclable by the Whitefish Bay Recycling Program at this time:

- Aluminum Foil
- Auto/Mirror or Tinted Glass
- Batteries
- Blueprints/Overhead transparencies
- Car parts, nails and screws
- Carpet
- Carbon paper
- Ceramic items (dishes, vases, cups)
- Clothing
- Crystal type materials or beverage glasses
- Disposable Diapers
- Domestic Refuse (bagged garbage)
- Foam used in packaging including peanuts - should be brought to special facility
- Food or food-soiled paper, cardboard, metal
- Flower plastic cartons and temporary holders
- Gasoline cans and scrap metal
- Glass Pyrex
- Hardcover Books
- Hazardous waste or containers
- Light bulbs
- Medical supplies
- Paper towels, napkins or facial tissue
- Pesticide and herbicide containers
- Pet-soiled paper
- Photography or Photographic paper
- Pizza boxes or carryout food wrappers or foil
- Plastic Bags of any kind
- Plastic toys, flower pots or garden plastics
- Pots and pans
- Rubber type materials or latex
- Self-adhesive labels
- Styrofoam (including egg cartons, microwave containers, other items labeled for recycling)
- Tissue paper, toilet paper
- Wrapping paper
- Yard Waste
